City Administrative Offices Open to the Public, by Appointment Only

As of May 18, City Administrative Offices re-opened to the public, by appointment only. If an in-person visit is required, please call 714-990-7600 to schedule an appointment. At this time, all other City facilities remain closed as we plan for their safe re-opening.

City staff is taking appropriate measures to ensure the safety of both employees and visitors. Face coverings are required to enter the building and appointment check-in is located at the 3rd floor reception desk of the Brea Civic & Cultural Center. Plexi glass barriers have been installed at all counters, hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the building and there is a limit of no more than three persons in an elevator at one time. We thank you for your cooperation in maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all.

The City of Brea Senior Center has suspended all programs and activities out of concern for public health and safety until further notice. The following essential services remain available for Brea residents, on a limited basis:

- Meals on Wheels Orange County Lunch Café Program (62+) — Our congregate lunch program has been converted to frozen take-home meals. Applications are required.
- One box of shelf-stable grocery products from Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County is available per senior household per week, until further notice.
- Transportation for Brea seniors (60+) to pick up lunches and groceries will continue on a reservation basis by calling (714) 990-7754.
- Case Management and Home Delivered Meals programs are available for Brea residents who meet eligibility criteria.
