## Keep Yourself and Our Community Safe



Help keep yourself and our community safe from the spread of COVID-19. Stay vigilant and remember these best practices:

- Wash your hands frequently and for at least 20 seconds.
- Wear a face covering.
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces, such as cell phones, door knobs, light switches, keys, etc.
- Physically distance from those you do not live with.

## California Requires Use of Face Coverings



**WEAR A MASK OR CLOTH FACE COVERING:**

- ✓ To slow the spread of COVID-19
- ✓ When out in public
- ✓ Made of tight-knit cloth, like cotton

In June, the state released new guidance requiring residents to wear face coverings when in public in order to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Those with special considerations, such as children younger than 2 and individuals with specified health conditions, are exempt. ### **It's required to wear a face covering...**

- Inside any indoor public space
- When using public transit or rideshare
- At workplaces in common areas
- For any food service, packaging or distribution
- In enclosed areas unable to maintain distance from those you do not live with
- Outdoors, when within six feet of others
