PAYING YOUR BILL - Your bill is due by the date indicated on the front side of this invoice. The City of Brea is happy to provide multiple options to pay your bill such as:

E-PAY - Pay online or by phone with an electronic check, debit or credit card. Visit www.cityofbrea.net or call toll free (877) 543-8356.

AUTOPAY - For added convenience, automatic payment (AutoPay) is available. To set up AutoPay, please visit <https://ipn.paymentus.com/rctp/brea>. Scroll down to Simply Your Life and follow the instructions to enroll in AutoPay.

BY MAIL - payment can be mailed to City of Brea, PO Box 2237, Brea, CA 92822-2237. We accept check, cashier's checks, and money order.

DROP BOX LOCATION - For your convenience, a payment box is located at the Brea Civic & Cultural Center, 1 Civic Center Circle (corner of Birch St. and Randolph Ave.) in the circular driveway along Birch Street.)

IN PERSON - Payment can be paid in person at City of Brea, 1 Civic Center Circle, Brea - 3rd Floor, Administrative Services Department. To ensure proper credit and quick payment posting, please bring your bill with you.

PAST DUE - To avoid a late charge of 10%, payment must be received in the Administrative Services Department by 5:30 p.m. on the DUE DATE. Accounts unpaid 45 days from the billing date will be tagged with a Shut Off Notice and incur a Hang Tag fee. If your water is shut off for non-payment, you will be required to pay ALL charges due on the account which may include a deposit and a reconnection fee before service will be re-established.

DISPUTED BILLS - Should you have questions concerning this bill, please email waterbilling@cityofbrea.org or call (714) 990-7687.

RETURNED ITEMS - A returned item fee will be charged for all returned checks/transactions.

EMERGENCY SERVICE - For after hours water emergencies, please call Police Dispatch at (714) 990-7911. A service fee may apply.

LOW INCOME RATE ASSISTANCE - The City has a "Lifeline Rate" for qualified low-income customers. To qualify, you must be a current participant in one of the following programs: Southern California Edison's "D-Care" or The Gas Company's "CARE Discount." To apply, simply mail a copy of your current Edison or Gas Company bill or email a copy to waterbilling@cityofbrea.net.

CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBILITY - The service account remains the customer's responsibility until the City is notified to discontinue service. Failure to receive a bill does not relieve the customer of liability.



To keep pace with rising costs of delivering water and sewer services, rate adjustments will take effect as noted below.
