



Wildcatters Dog Park... 10 Months Later

January 2015 will mark the one-year anniversary of the Wildcatters Dog Park opening. We sincerely appreciate your patience while the Parks have undergone additional park maintenance since opening just 10-months ago, and are happy to report the success of installing an additional drain line and correcting the gate entrance gaps. Please know that we strive to provide a better Dog Park while adapting to sustainable maintenance for the amount of use the Parks endure.

Large Dog Park Sod Project

The City of Brea Public Works Department has been testing various types of sod at the large Dog Park to see which type of sod can endure heavy traffic by park users. The turf in the large Park wears quickly, and the City wants to provide the best surface possible for both the dogs and their handlers. Currently, there are three different sod testing areas with the characteristics of quick establishment, fast spreading, and toleration to high traffic. Each section will be monitored by City staff to see which will work best for future turf repair.

Both Parks are closed for maintenance from 7 a.m. to noon on Thursdays.

Lastly, since autumn is here and winter is just around the corner, please keep in mind that City staff may periodically close the Parks due to inclement weather.
