



Santa Fe Road Traffic Enhancements - Update!

As communicated in the October e-newsletter, you may have already noticed traffic enhancements along Santa Fe Road adjacent to the dog parks, including extended red curbs/fire lanes, a double-yellow centerline, and soon - a high-visibility crosswalk immediately outside the large dog park. These enhancements are part of the City's larger [Traffic Calming Plan](#), created by the Blackstone & Olinda Ranch developer and nearby residents, as well as staff from the County and City of Brea. One of the goals of the Plan is to make Santa Fe Road safer, hence "enhancements."

Please keep in mind that it is legal to crossover the new double-yellow centerline to make a left-hand turn into and out of Wildcatters parking lots.

The installation of the high-visibility pedestrian crosswalk outside the large dog park has been delayed to December. It will connect the dog parks to the parking lot across Santa Fe Road. Another crosswalk will be installed further west on Santa Fe Road, at Discovery Lane. Once installed, please use the crosswalks to cross Santa Fe Road safely.

We appreciate your patience in this endeavor.



Turf Replacement Plan... Still in Progress.

Also as communicated in the October e-newsletter, thank you (again) to everyone who participated in the recent Turf Replacement Plan Survey. A good response was received with great, but varied feedback. The feedback is being further researched and evaluated by City staff, as well as the Parks, Recreation and Human Services Commission. The City is hopeful to adopt a plan in/by next spring, which will be communicated.
